



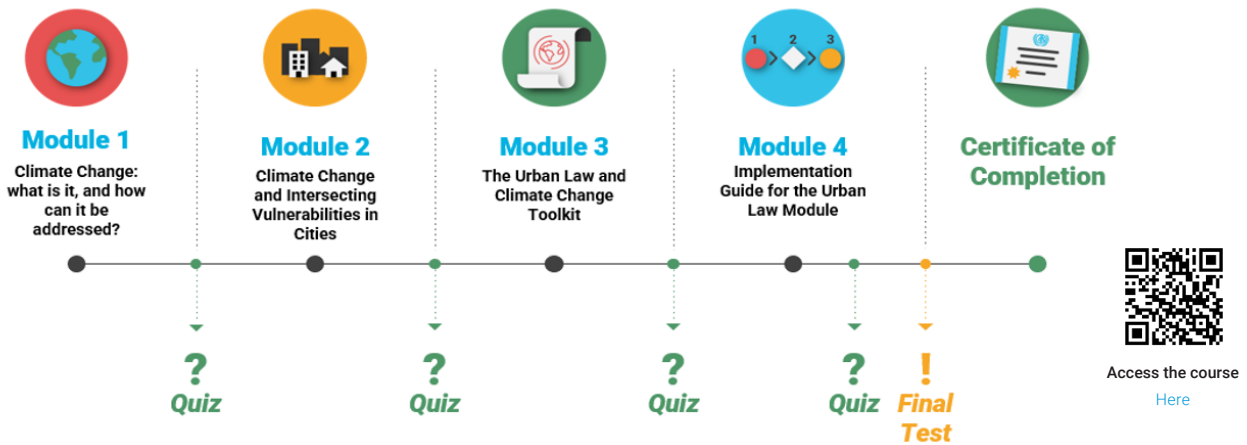

ii. "Advancing Climate Action through Urban Law" e-learning course: This course explores the essential role that urban law plays in addressing the challenges of climate change. It delves into UN-Habitat's Urban Law Module of the Law and Climate Change Toolkit, which is a valuable resource for countries, local governments, professionals, academia and other stakeholders

seeking to adapt their urban planning and environmental regulations and policies to manage climate change effectively. This course was launched during COP28 and can be accessed via UN-Habitat's hub of e-learning tools, Habitat Learn. In the first month of its launch, the course was accessed by 167 learners globally, with 17 successfully completing the course.

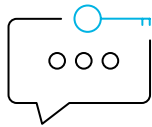
