





Costa Rica: national guidelines In Costa Rica, a network coordinated by the national government developed guidelines for local authorities to build an action plan for COVID response adaptation to the context of slums and informal settlements.

#### Freetown: Local adaptation

Freetown developed a local actin plan to adapt the national measures to the context of slums in preparedness, response and recovery phases including actions to reinforce and tailor national measures in informal settlements.


